<b>34</b>	<b>Ruger SR</b> series of models (pages 12-16 of the <u>Approved Firearms Roster</u> ): the loaded chamber indicator is a protruding tab on top of the slide, behind the ejection port.
<b>35</b>	<b>Sig Sauer</b> model 226 Mk-25 (pages 6-7 of the <u>Approved Firearms Roster</u> ): the loaded chamber indicator is a protruding tab on top of the slide, behind the ejection port.
<b>36</b>	<b>Remington Arms</b> model 1911R1 (page 6 of the <u>Approved Firearms Roster</u> ): the loaded chamber indicator is a hole at the rear of the barrel (chamber) through which one must look to observe whether there is a cartridge in the chamber.
<b>37</b>	<b>Smith &amp; Wesson</b> Bodyguard 380 (pages 7-11 of the <u>Approved Firearms Roster</u> ): the loaded chamber indicator is a hole at the rear of the barrel (chamber) through which one must look to observe whether there is a cartridge in the chamber.
<b>38</b>	<b>Walther Arms</b> model P99 (page 16 of the <u>Approved Firearms Roster</u> ): the loaded chamber indicator is a colored recess in the right side of the slide behind the ejection port which comes into view when the extractor engages the rim of a cartridge in the chamber.
<b>39</b>	<b>Kahr Arms</b> (all models) (pages 3-4 of the <u>Approved Firearms Roster</u> ): the loaded chamber indicator is part of the extractor, and protrudes from the right side of the slide behind the ejection port.
<b>40</b>	<b>Heckler &amp; Koch</b> USP series of models (pages 3 of the <u>Approved Firearms Roster</u> ): the loaded chamber indicator is part of the extractor, and protrudes from the right side of the slide behind the ejection port.
<b>41</b>	<b>Beretta</b> 92 series of models (pages 1-2 of the <u>Approved Firearms Roster</u> ): the loaded chamber indicator is part of the extractor, and protrudes from the right side of the slide behind the ejection port.
<b>42</b>	<b>Glock</b> (all Gen3 models) single-page Instruction Manual insert (front and back) (pages 2-3 of the <u>Approved Firearms Roster</u> ): the loaded chamber indicator is part of the extractor, and protrudes from the right side of the slide behind the ejection port.
<b>43</b>	<b>Glock</b> (all Gen 4 models) (pages 2-3 of the <u>Approved Firearms Roster</u> ): the loaded chamber indicator is part of the extractor, and protrudes from the right side of the slide behind the ejection port.
